The Birth of St Mary's House

In 1984 the PCC of St Mary's Church, Broughton, submitted a planning application for a Common Room to be built in Broughton and a public meeting was held to launch the plan in October 1986. The village had no public place for meetings and any such gathering could only be held on private property. The population at the time was 306. The original capital to obtain planning permission was provided by Bodicote Housing Association who also bought ground near the Alms Houses in the village and leased it in perpetuity at a peppercorn rent. The building cost was estimated to be £60,000 and by February 1988 £37,000 had been raised. Apart from individual donations, £2,000 was raised by special events in the village. The Parish Council, Cherwell District Council, Help the Aged, Housing Associations, and Charitable Trust for the Elderly made or promised donations. Grants were requested from Oxfordshire County Council and Oxford Diocese.



The £60,000 required was eventually raised and the building of St Mary's House was completed in 1989. Some of the committee members responsible for us having our own meeting place in Broughton are pictured above. Some people might be able to recognise some familiar faces, sadly some are no longer with us. Thank you to all for allowing us to use the photograph.
