As many of you may have noticed, the bench in Jubilee Gardens has had a makeover and has now been reinstated.

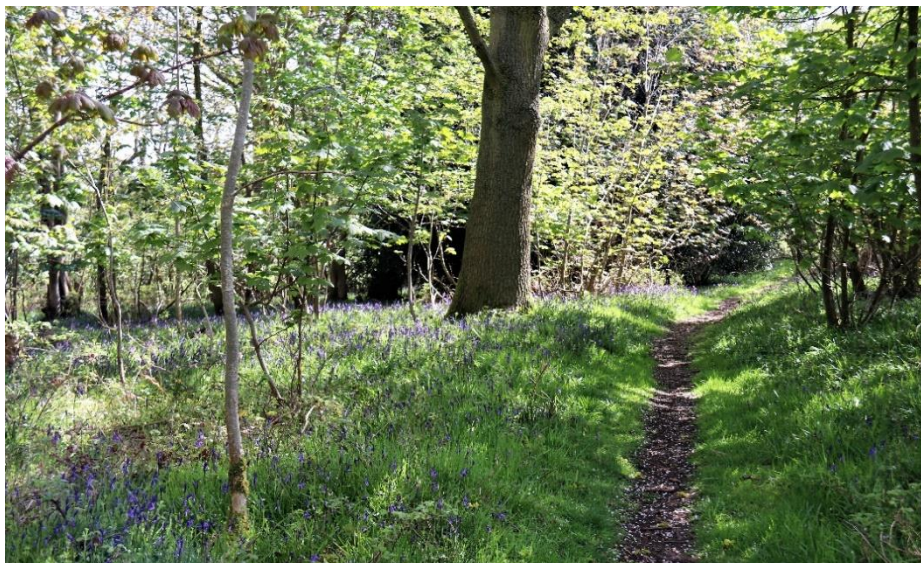

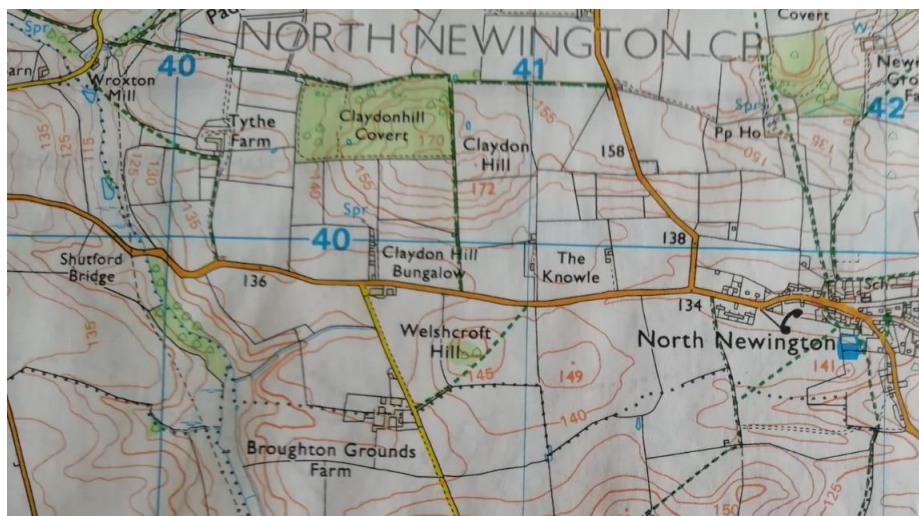
